

Contracts, Grants, and Sponsored Projects in the UGA FAR

Currently, the FAR pre-populates only proposals/awards that are managed by the Office of Sponsored Programs. Following is a list of types of proposals/awards that are NOT pre-populated in FAR profiles because they are not managed by the Office for Sponsored Programs. All financial awards to you that do not appear in the FAR should be recorded by you under “Additional Scholarship” in the “Scholarship . . .” section of the FAR Main Menu.

Proposals/Awards not pre-populated:

- A. Proposals/awards associated with internal funding programs (e.g., UGARF, CHA, departmental or college awards, Learning Technology Grants, etc.).
- B. Awards made directly to you and not to UGA nor UGARF (e.g., certain personal fellowships or prizes).
- C. Funding provided as a state appropriation to the University through the Board of Regents (e.g., Georgia Research Alliance funding).
- D. Funding provided directly to OVPR through the State of Georgia’s Traditional Industries Program (Consortium on Competitiveness for the Apparel, Carpet, and Textile Industry (CCACTI); FoodPac; or Pulp and Paper).
- E. Funded awards to other institutions for which UGA/UGARF is not specifically identified as a sub-awardee, even though you may be listed as a CoPI. You would typically be fulfilling obligations to such projects as a consultant.

NOTE: (this function is under construction) If you are a sub-awardee on a federal award, and the PI for this award is in another legal entity, the sponsor name will be displayed with the sponsoring agency in parentheses, followed by the PI’s legal entity. For example: (NIH) Clemson University.
